KNOW YOUR RIGHTS!

As a UAW represented Academic Student Employee, you have the right to a union representative at a meeting with your supervisor if there is reason to believe disciplinary action will result. This is commonly known as your "Weingarten Rights".

The following language is often used to assert Weingarten rights: "If this discussion could in any way lead to my being disciplined or terminated, or affect my personal working conditions, I respectfully request that my union representative, officer or steward be present at the meeting. Without representation, I choose not to answer any questions."

Keep them in mind. It's your right.
