The term "significantly close relative" shall mean a spouse, domestic partner, the employee's or his/her spouse's mother, father, grandmother, grandfather, grandchild, son, son-in-law, daughter, daughter-in-law, brother, sister, or relative living in the immediate household of the employee. All employees covered under a Collective Bargaining Agreement (CBA) may also use funeral leave for the death of an aunt or uncle of the employee, spouse or domestic partner. ¹ Restrictions apply to hourly employees. ² The President may authorize up to forty (40) hours of accrued sick leave for bereavement. When one or more deaths occur in a calendar year, up to forty (40) hours of accrued sick leave credits may be authorized for each death. The death of a person in the immediate family as used in this Article shall mean close relative or other person residing in the immediate household of the employee, except domestic employees, roomers or roommates.
